

3. Rhythm

Mouse Game

Materials: 4 Beat 'Cheese' Rhythm cards

- Lay the Cheese Rhythm cards randomly on the floor. Children become little mice looking for cheese. At 'nibble nibble' the children stop and find a piece of cheese. Choose a child to read their cheese card.

Pitter, patter, little feet – could it be a mouse?

Pitter, patter – LOTS of mice are creeping through the house!

Looking here and looking there – find a piece of cheese.

Nibble Nibble 'name' mouse – can you read yours please?



4. Melody

Starlight, Starbright

Materials: 9 Taa & 7 TiTi cards

Instruments: Chime Bars (green and orange)

- Before class, display the rhythm cards for 'Starlight, Starbright'.
- Using body movements, place the cards in the melodic shape.
- Children play the song on the chime bars.

5. Movement

The Thread Follows The Needle

- Children form one long line, holding hands. The child at one end is the 'needle' and the child on the other end is the 'knot'. **The knot cannot move.**
- The needle leads the children down the line towards the knot. When the needle reaches the knot, the knot and second last child raise arms so the needle and the rest of the children follow through under the arch. The needle leads them back to the original starting position. The second last child will have turned (without dropping hands) and arms will be crossed.
- Sing the song again, while the needle leads the children down the line and under the arms of the second & third last child and back to the
